Pronunciation	Student <b>uses</b> correct pronunciation. There is exceptional control and expression. No errors present.	Student uses <b>mostly</b> <b>correct</b> pronunciation, though a few errors may occur. There is <b>competence</b> and <b>few</b> <b>errors present.</b>	Student <b>sometimes uses</b> <b>correct</b> pronunciation, but also makes many errors. Though <b>comprehensible</b> , there are <b>some errors present.</b>	Student <b>seldom uses</b> <b>correct</b> pronunciation. The presentation may or may not be comprehensible, but there are several <b>errors</b> <b>present.</b>
Confidence and Poise	Student <b>demonstrates</b> <b>excellent</b> confidence and poise throughout the entire Presentation.	Student demonstrates adequate confidence and poise throughout <b>most of</b> <b>the presentation.</b>	Student is confident and poised for <b>some of the</b> <b>presentation</b> , but may also demonstrate <b>some doubt</b> <b>or difficulty.</b>	Student is <b>unable to</b> <b>maintain</b> confidence and poise during the presentation.
Intonation and Expression	Student <b>uses excellent</b> intonation and expression, indicating a <b>deep comprehension</b> of the poem and its content.	Student uses intonation and expression in a <b>competent</b> way, demonstrating <b>good</b> <b>comprehension</b> of the poem and its content.	Student uses intonation and expression <b>effectively</b> , but may make <b>some</b> <b>errors</b> , which reflect only a <b>basic comprehension</b> of the poem and its content.	Student is <b>mostly unable</b> to use intonation and expression effectively during their presentation, indicating <b>incomplete</b> <b>comprehension</b> of the poem and its content.
Vocal Delivery	Vocal delivery is <b>varied</b> and <b>dynamic.</b> Speech rate, volume and tone enhance listener interest and understanding	Vocal delivery is <b>clear</b> and <b>distinct</b> . Rate, volume and tone facilitate audience comprehension.	Vocal delivery is <b>audible.</b> Rate volume or speech disruptions only occasionally distract from audience comprehension.	Vocal delivery is <b>too slow</b> or <b>too fast</b> to understand and/or long, unintended silences and speech disruptions (repetition; filled pauses, e.g., "um") frequently distract audience.
Content	Central idea/purpose is vividly stated; content is accurate, thorough, and directly on point; strong support is provided for each assertion.	<b>Central idea/purpose</b> is clearly stated; content is accurate and relevant; credible support is provided for each assertion.	<b>Central idea/purpose</b> is stated; content is accurate but not always relevant; support is offered but inadequate for some assertions.	<b>Central idea/purpose</b> Is not stated; content is erroneous or irrelevant; support for assertions is largely absent
